
MEETING INFO

CQ WORLD WW DX SSB CONTEST

We will operate in the upcoming CQ World Wide DX SSB contest on October 24 and 25 from WAS. Our plan is to arrive after breakfast and set up two stations to operate Multi-operator Multi-transmitter. The CQ World Wide DX SSB contest begins at 00:00 UTC October 24 (8 pm Friday night Oct 23) and runs a full 48 hours. Our plan is to operate all day Saturday in a Social Distancing mode, with masks and gloves. With two transmitters, this contest does allow us to operate Multi-operator single transmitter, with the first transmitter as the "run" station and the second transmitter as the "multiplier" station. (yep, we can have two transmitters in the single transmitter category.) Please read the rules on the CQ Amateur Radio rules page, as they are quite different for this contest than any contest we have operated before! 






KB1LTW-10 APRS i-GATE
